Deer Lodge Return To Play Initiative

To Membership,

The following are the procedures that will be put in place due to the ongoing coronavirus epidemic. It is important to remember that these procedures are fluid and can change as the coronavirus situation continues to evolve in Manitoba. Please let us know if you have any questions

- DLCC Board of directors

General Procedures:

- The club will abide by all province of Manitoba regulations related to coronavirus (ie. limits on gatherings, social distancing, etc.)
- If you are sick, you should not come to curl
- DLCC reserves the right to send people home who are exhibiting signs of sickness
- Masks are not required, but left to personal choice
- The club will not be lending out equipment this season due to the labour involved in sanitization

Building Procedures:

- Hand sanitizer stations will be available for use throughout the building
- Stairwells and doors will be clearly designated for entrance and exit to the lounge, ice and parking lot
- Lockers will be open for use, but curlers are encouraged to either arrive early to allow for wait time or arrive clothed
- Lounge is open (abiding by social distancing rules) but bar service will only be done at the tables, no standing service allowed (including payment)

Curling Procedures:

- Alternating sheets will start at opposite ends (1,3,5 home end – 2,4,6 away end)
- All universal equipment (rocks, numbers, etc.) will be sanitized by the ice crew before each draw
- Curlers will only handle their own rocks as well as only one person marking score for the game
- No handshakes or coin flip at the start of the game (rock paper scissors or something without contact)
- Water fountain and the hog line bell will also be out of service
- The bar phone will be out of service. Servers will come down and take orders regularly
