#### Flock Inducted Into HOF!

Bob Flock, who was a longtime DLCC member, was inducted into the Manitoba Curling of Fame at an induction banquet in Brandon on May 7. He was inducted in the builder category.

Flock started curling in the Deer Lodge junior program in 1958. In 1964, he skipped his St. James Collegiate team to the final of the Manitoba School Boys Championship.

He won the Manitoba Police Curling Championship nine times, capturing the Canadian title in 1981. Flock started the annual Police & Pal Bonspiel in 1974, and he was the coordinator for all 19 years the event was held.

For his leadership in Manitoba curling, he was made an Honourary Life Member of the Manitoba Curling Association in 1995. He chaired the Accreditation Committee at the 2003 World Curling Championships and 2008 Tim Horton's Brier, both hosted in Winnipeg.
